Agenda Item: 5C2**

ACTION: Adopt a resolution to accept donations from the Weight Loss Institute of Arizona's Every Step of the Way Relay and authorize the use of such donations. (Resolution No. R2016.46)

FISCAL IMPACT: The amount of the donation through June 30, 2016 is \$10,175.50. Sufficient budget appropriations for expenditure of this donation were authorized in the Governmental Grants and Donations Fund (Fund 44, cost center 44407) as part of the fiscal year 2015-16 adopted budget.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution No. R2016.46.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The City of Tempe's Kid Zone Enrichment Program operates in 17 schools throughout the city providing before and after school enrichment programs. The program offers affordable care; low staff to child ratios with Department of Health Services licensed facilities and staff. Participants are able to develop their cognitive, social and physical skills through the structured activities that align directly with the school district's curriculum. The program currently offers Nutrition and Physical Education instruction to participants in Title I schools through a grant funded through the Arizona Nutrition Network and the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

The Weight Loss Institute of Arizona (WLIA) celebrated its 10 year anniversary and sponsored the Every Step of the Way Relay and chose the City of Tempe – Kid Zone Enrichment Program as the beneficiary of any donations received as part of the event. The donations will allow Kid Zone to expand Nutrition and Education programming to its sites that do not currently have such services.

The purpose of the donation funds is to enable the City of Tempe – Kid Zone Enrichment Program to expand the Nutrition and Physical Education Program ("Program") to six school sites that do not currently qualify for the program based on income level regulations per the USDA grant guidelines. Staff time spent in administering the expanded Program will be derived from existing appropriation in the Community Services General Fund budget.
