

RESOLUTION NO. 2012.87

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING A PILOT PROGRAM TO ESTABLISH PROCESSES FOR THE CONTROL OF NOISE.

WHEREAS, the City of Tempe has a vested interest in promoting the health, safety and welfare of its residents, citizens, businesses and visitors, and;

WHEREAS, a variety of issues including vehicles, performances, music, commercial traffic, pedestrian traffic and equipment contribute to a high level of ambient noise in Tempe; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the City of Tempe to undertake a pilot program for the term of one (1) year, to establish terms and conditions to govern the rights and responsibilities of persons to prohibit all noises that are disturbing or unreasonably loud, in order to further the peace, quiet and comfort of Tempe neighborhoods;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, as follows:

1. That the City of Tempe establish processes for the different levels and types of sound for specific zones and areas.
2. That should the need arise, the Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to execute any documents that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this resolution.
