Agenda Item: 5B3

ACTION: Approve the utilization of a one-year State of Arizona contract with Ennis Paint Incorporated for the purchase of traffic marking paint used by the Public Works Department.

FISCAL IMPACT: Total cost of this contract will not exceed \$85,000. Sufficient funds have been appropriated in the Highway User Revenue Fund – cost center 3823 (Operations - Transportation) – for the anticipated expenditures in the current fiscal year.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the utilization of the contract.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: (State of Arizona ADOT11-006021) The State of Arizona solicited and awarded a contract for the purchase of traffic marking paint which contains cooperative language allowing its use by other governmental agencies. The State of Arizona utilized a competitive bid process that established pricing based on purchase volumes anticipated for the State and other utilizing governmental agencies.

The Transportation Maintenance Section of Public Works purchases paint under this contract to maintain striping on the 1,241 lane miles of roadways under the City's care. This fiscal year, 600 lane miles of arterial and collector streets are scheduled to be restriped.

The paint offered by Ennis Paint meets Tempe specifications and is offered at market competitive pricing.
