Agenda Item: 5E6

ACTION: Adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor or designee(s) to execute an agreement between the State of Arizona, Governor's Office of Highway Safety and the Tempe Police Department to accept federal grant funds for impaired driver/DUI alcohol enforcement. (Resolution No. 2013.118)

FISCAL IMPACT: The amount of the total grant award is \$50,000.00. This grant award will supplement the Police Department's existing General Fund budget appropriation. Sufficient budget appropriation for expenditure of this grant was authorized in the Police Department Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organization and Grants Fund (Fund 45) as part of the fiscal year 2013-14 adopted budget.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution No. 2013.118.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The Tempe Police Department will utilize this grant funding for the purpose of funding overtime and employee related expenses related to DUI task forces; continue participating in the East Valley DUI Task Force; provide traffic safety training for enforcement to law enforcement personnel; and develop public educational campaigns to raise awareness in reducing fatalities and collisions.
