

**CITY OF TEMPE
REQUEST FOR COUNCIL ACTION**
**Council Meeting Date: 1/10/2013
Agenda Item: 5E1**

ACTION: Adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute an intergovernmental agreement between the Salt River Pima – Maricopa Indian Community and the City of Tempe for the purpose of accepting and disbursing a portion of the 12% gaming proceeds for 2012. (Resolution No. 2013.01)

FISCAL IMPACT: For 2012, of the \$1,486,019 to be distributed has awarded \$48,000 to the City of Tempe for the Early Literacy skills tutoring program and \$300,000 to the Rio Salado Foundation for Eisendrath House renovations. The remaining \$1,138,019 gaming proceeds has been awarded to 12 area non-city organizations.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution No. 2013.01.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: State law, A.R.S. § 5-601.02, requires participating tribal communities to contribute 12% of their annual gaming proceeds to local governments for government services that benefit the general public, including public safety, mitigation of gaming impacts, and the promotion of commerce and economic development. In the spirit of regional cooperation, City of Tempe acts as a pass through for a portion of Salt River Pima – Maricopa Indian Community’s statutory contribution to organizations to which the tribe has awarded a grant.

To act as a pass through for SRPMIC requires two approvals by the City Council. First, approval of the resolution that accompanies this request for council action, which allows the City to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with SRPMIC so the City of Tempe is able to accept the contribution from Salt River Pima – Maricopa Indian Community and pass it through to the recipients that SRPMIC has selected. Second, approval of another resolution which allows the City of Tempe to enter into funding agreements with the 13 non-city recipients that govern the relationship between the City of Tempe as a pass through for SRPMIC and the non-city recipients.

Adoption of Resolution No. 2013.01 allows the City of Tempe to act as a pass through for SRPMIC’s contribution to the following organizations for the amount awarded and for the associated purpose:

Recipient	Amount	Purpose
American Red Cross	\$100,000.00	For the local disaster response program in the Grand Canyon chapter.
ASU/Indian Legal Services	\$100,000.00	For student scholarships; the Indian Legal Clinic; Indian Rights Fellowships; and Community Outreach efforts.
ASU Public Affairs	\$7,000.00	For programming for the American Indian Newly Elected Officials program.
Center for the Future of Arizona	\$50,000.00	For the Beat the Odds Program for training K-12 principals for low income, high-minority school districts.
City of Tempe for Early Literacy	\$48,000.00	For a skills tutoring program for kindergarten students in Tempe and Kyrene elementary school districts.
City of Tempe – Rio Salado Foundation	\$300,000.00	For renovations of the Eisendrath House.
Hacienda Healthcare	\$200,000.00	For construction of a sub-acute care children’s hospital.
Phoenix Children’s Hospital	\$200,000.00	For multiple programs, including funding a Diabetes Program Coordinator; a bilingual/bicultural Program Assistant; and a part time licensed pediatric nutritionist.
Phoenix Symphony	\$75,000.00	For their Education and Community Engagement Programs.

Phoenix Zoo	\$135,000.00	For the Piper Foundation Challenge grant to create a front entry oasis project.
Ryan House	\$100,000.00	For the "Sponsor-A-Stay" project that funds 24-hour respite stay for every child with a life-threatening condition.
Salvation Army	\$100,000.00	For food, shelter and emergency services to families in Maricopa County.
Tempe Preparatory Academy	\$75,000.00	For the completion of a Chemistry Science Laboratory.
Tempe Union High School District	\$21,019	For GED programs and funding for a post-secondary instructor.
