ACTION: Adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign an intergovernmental agreement between the Maricopa County Human Services Department and the City of Tempe to implement a youth employment program at the Escalante Community Center. (Resolution No. 2013.123)

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution No. 2013.123.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: This intergovernmental agreement will provide a new youth workforce development program to the City of Tempe. The purpose of youth workforce investment activities is intended to provide youth development services to economically disadvantaged youth 14 through 21 years of age who may face barriers to staying in school, completing high school or finding stable employment. Services for In-school youth ages 14 to 21 will be provided after school hours and may include: tutoring, study skills, career exploration, life skills, work readiness and pro-social activities. Services for Out-of school youth ages 16 to 21 may also include employment skills, paid/unpaid work experience, job shadowing, job and career fairs, college and or apprenticeship tours, and instruction on applying for federal financial aid programs and scholarships.
