**Council Meeting Date: 09/08/2016
Agenda Item: 5B6**

ACTION: Approve a one-year contract renewal with Fluoresco Lighting and Signs for streetlight installation.

FISCAL IMPACT: Total cost of this one-year contract renewal will not exceed \$375,000 during the one-year renewal period. Sufficient funds have been appropriated in the Traffic Signals CIP Fund – cost center 6999849 (Streetlight Pole Replacement) – for the anticipated expenditures.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the renewal of the contract.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: (T14-031) City Council originally approved the award of a contract to Fluoresco Lighting and Signs on October 24, 2013 for an initial one-year period with four one-year renewal options. This renewal request is the third of four available renewal options.

The contract is utilized to install new poles, replace poles that have become structurally unsound, or to replace poles that have been knocked down. There are 11,415 streetlights maintained by the City of Tempe.
