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**ACTION:** Approve an increase of the contract amount with Ennis Paint Incorporated for the purchase of traffic marking paint used by the Public Works Department.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Total spending on this contract will not exceed \$86,000 and will increase the contract amount from \$49,999 to \$86,000. Sufficient funds have been appropriated in the Highway User Revenue Fund – cost center 3823 – for the anticipated expenditures in the current fiscal year.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the increase in the contract amount.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** (ADOT11-006021) The State of Arizona solicited and awarded a contract for the purchase of traffic marking paint which contains cooperative language allowing its utilization by other public agencies. The quality of the product is good and pricing offered is competitive in the marketplace.

The Transportation Maintenance Section of Public Works purchases paint under this contract to maintain striping on the 1,241 lane miles of roadways under the City's care. This fiscal year, 447 lane miles of arterial streets and 50 miles of collector street are scheduled to be restriped.

Initial anticipated spending was not expected to exceed \$49,999 and contract utilization was administratively approved by the Procurement Office on June 9, 2013. Spending for the one-year contract period is now expected to be in a range that requires City Council approval.
