**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, ADOPTING THE TITLE VI
ASSURANCES DOCUMENT.**

WHEREAS, the purpose of Title VI of the United States Civil Rights Act of 1964 and subsequent legislation, regulations, statutes and orders is to prohibit programs that receive federal funds from discriminating against participants on the basis of race, color, national origin, disability, age, gender, or income status; and

WHEREAS, the intent of the federal authorities is to ensure that all persons regardless of their race, color, national origin, disability, age, gender, or income status are allowed to participate in federally funded programs; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of a written and signed Title VI Assurances document that expresses the City's commitment to ensure non-discrimination within any of its activities, programs or projects is a federal requirement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tempe hereby gives assurance that it will comply with all requirements and federal mandates.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, as follows:

The Title VI Assurances document is hereby approved and adopted.
