**ACTION:** Adopt a resolution approving receipt and expenditure of a grant from Arizona State University Office of Entrepreneurship and Innovation to provide funding for Youth Entrepreneurship Programming at the Business Resource and Innovation Center at Tempe Public Library. (Resolution No. R2016.80)

**FISCAL IMPACT:** The amount of the grant award is \$850. Acceptance of this grant does not require any matching city funds. Sufficient budget appropriation for expenditure of this grant is authorized in the Governmental Grants (Fund 46) as part of the FY 2016-17 adopted budget.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution No. R2016.80.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** On July 25, 2016 the Business Resource and Innovation Center (BRIC) opened at the Tempe Public Library as part of the Economic Development Department's strategy to serve small businesses and entrepreneurs. In alignment with the Community Service Department's services to Tempe youth, Economic Development Department staff sought input on how to best incorporate appropriate programming at BRIC for Tempe Youth. Youth entrepreneurship training was recommended and Arizona State University's Office of Entrepreneurship and Innovation offered a grant to help launch a Youth Entrepreneurship Boot Camp based on the principals of ASU Start-up School adapted for a youth audience.
