

RESOLUTION NO. R2016.96

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN CHANGE ORDER NUMBER ONE TO EXTEND THE TERM OF AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF PHOENIX.

WHEREAS, Chapter 53 of 49 United States Code (formerly the Federal Transit Act of 1964, as amended) makes financial aid available to municipalities and local units of government showing a substantial effort toward the preservation, improvement and operation of mass transit systems; and

WHEREAS, the City of Phoenix, who is the designated recipient by the FTA for the Phoenix-Mesa Urbanized Area, is responsible for receiving, distributing and tracking federal funds to sub-recipients, including the City of Tempe; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Tempe applied for unspent federal formula funds provided by the FTA's Urbanized Area Formula Grants 49 U.S.C. § 5307, to fund the construction of Liquefied Natural Compressed Gas Fuel Pump Expansion, Route 56 Bus Stop and Pullout Improvements, and East Valley Bus Operations and Maintenance Facility Building System Carbon Dioxide Sensor Replacement; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the Grant No.AZ-90-X124, the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Phoenix and the City of Tempe, (C2014-48) sets forth the duties and responsibilities of the parties and the term of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Intergovernmental Agreement, the City shall receive grant funds as reimbursements for the federal share of the expenditures associated the construction of Liquefied Natural Compressed Gas Fuel Pump Expansion, Route 56 Bus Stop and Pullout Improvements, and East Valley Bus Operations and Maintenance Facility Building System Carbon Dioxide Sensor Replacement; and,

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the effective date of the Agreement to June 30, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, as follows:

That the Mayor is authorized to sign Change Order One to the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Phoenix and the City of Tempe.
