

RESOLUTION NO. R2015.51

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF SCOTTSDALE RELATING TO REALLOCATION OF FEDERAL HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP FUNDING.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the existing Maricopa HOME Consortium Intergovernmental Agreement (Consortium IGA) by and among Maricopa County and the cities/towns of Avondale, Chandler, Gilbert, Glendale, Peoria, Scottsdale, Surprise and Tempe, effective for the federal fiscal years 2012 through 2015, on April 2, 2015 the Consortium voted to reallocate \$579,351.11 of HOME Program funds from the City of Scottsdale to the City of Tempe; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the Consortium IGA require that the City of Scottsdale and the City of Tempe memorialize their agreement with respect to the reallocation of HOME funds in a written intergovernmental agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, as follows:

That the Mayor is authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Scottsdale in substantially the form on file with the City Clerk, and to execute all documents referenced therein, and any other documents reasonably required to effectuate, or that may be necessary or convenient to carry out the provisions of this Resolution or the Intergovernmental Agreement.
