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**ACTION:** Adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute the Grant Agreement between the Arizona Criminal Justice Commission and the City of Tempe to accept and disburse a state grant for the provision of CARE 7 victim services. (Resolution No. 2013.94)

**FISCAL IMPACT:** The amount of the grant award through June 30, 2014 is \$27,349. Sufficient budget appropriations for expenditure of this grant were authorized in the Governmental Grants and Donations Fund (Fund 46), as part of the 2013-14 adopted budget. Acceptance of the grant requires matching fund in the amount of \$27,349. City-funded personnel time for supervisor and grant oversight will be paid from existing appropriation in the Community Services Department's General Fund budget (Cost Center 2485) and will fulfill the City's required match.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution No. 2013.94.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** The grant funds and City match provide one temporary, non-benefitted part-time CARE 7 victim advocate. The position provides victims with timely access to crisis counseling, emergency housing/shelter, food, linkage to individual and group counseling, and other services, and criminal justice advocacy. This is the twelfth consecutive year this grant has been awarded to the City of Tempe's CARE 7 Program.
