ACTION: Approve a two-year contract renewal with MISCOWater for Siemens sludge removal parts on an as needed basis.

FISCAL IMPACT: Total cost of this two-year contract renewal will not exceed \$400,000. Sufficient funds are available in the Water Wastewater Fund - cost center 3013 (Johnny G. Martinez Plant) for the anticipated expenditures.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the contract renewal.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: (WUD14-111-01) The City Council originally approved a two-year contract award for sludge removal parts that will expire on May 30, 2016. This renewal request is the first of two available two-year renewal options.

The sludge removal parts are used to remove solids from the water treatment process in the production of drinking water.
