

RESOLUTION NO. R2016.55

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, APPROVING THE NAMING OF THE JOHN GANNON LITERACY CENTER WITHIN THE TEMPE PUBLIC LIBRARY.

WHEREAS, the History Museum and Library Advisory Board recommended that a future youth literacy center within the Tempe Public Library be named the “John Gannon Literacy Center” on April 6, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Tempe is authorized to review and approve this recommended action for the naming of City facilities under Resolution No. 2012.130;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, HEREBY:

Section 1. Grants approval of the naming request for a future youth literacy center within the Tempe Public Library to be named the “John Gannon Literacy Center.”

Section 2. Gives authority to the Community Services Director or designee, to act as agent of the City of Tempe to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents and take such further actions as may be needed to effectuate this approval.
