

ORDINANCE NO. O2016.36

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, AMENDING CHAPTER 6, ARTICLE II, DIVISION 1, TEMPE CITY CODE, RELATING TO DOGS, CATS, ETC., GENERALLY, BY AMENDING SECTION 6-31.

WHEREAS, the purpose of this ordinance is to promote the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Tempe, Arizona, and to protect the community against hazardous waste;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 6, Article II, Division 1, Section 6-31 of the Tempe City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 6-31. Removal of animal defecation from public parks, PUBLIC STREETS, ALLEYS, GUTTERS, SIDEWALKS, RIGHTS-OF-WAY and school grounds.

(a) An owner or person having custody of any dog or any other animal shall not permit said dog or any other animal to defecate on any school ground, PUBLIC STREET, ALLEY, GUTTER, SIDEWALK, RIGHT-OF-WAY or public park, unless said defecation is removed immediately.

(b) Animal defecation which is removed from a school ground, PUBLIC STREET, ALLEY, GUTTER, SIDEWALK, RIGHT-OF-WAY or public park may be deposited in a garbage receptacle upon such ~~school ground or public park~~ PROPERTY if the defecation is first placed in a sealed plastic bag.

Section 2. Pursuant to City Charter, Section 2.12, ordinances are effective thirty (30) days after adoption.
