Agenda Item: 5C2**

ACTION: Adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute a Funding Agreement between the Tempe Community Action Agency and the City of Tempe memorializing the human services relationship functions between the parties. (Resolution No. R2016.66)

FISCAL IMPACT: Beginning July 2016, the City shall provide TCAA one-time funding for the administration of Tempe's Community Action Program ("CAP") in the total amount of \$206,000 and the administration of the Senior Action Program ("SAP") in the total amount of \$111,600, both which shall be paid in quarterly installments. Also, beginning July 2016, the City shall provide one-time additional funding of \$48,000 payable in quarterly installments, which funds are designated to provide rental assistance to Tempe residents. Sufficient budget appropriation for the anticipated expenditures have been authorized in the General Fund (cost center 3529, Tempe Community Action Agency) as part of the fiscal year 2016-17 adopted budget.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution No. R2016.66.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Tempe Community Action Agency ("TCAA") is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation committed to acting as a social service organization, serving the elderly and low-income community members in Tempe. Tempe has partnered with the TCAA since 1966, by providing funding directly to TCAA (and indirectly through the Tempe Community Council) to assist TCAA in its efforts to provide human services to the community.

TCAA and Tempe have decided to enter into a written agreement that clearly memorializes the obligations of the two entities and the consideration received by Tempe in exchange for its financial and in-kind support.

No extensions of this AGREEMENT will be considered by the City because future TCAA funding requests will be considered through the Tempe Community Council (TCC) Agency Review process.
