

**RESOLUTION NO. R2016.70**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE CITY COUNCIL TO APPROVE AND THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF ARIZONA FOR THE DESIGN PROCESS OF THE WESTERN CANAL MULTI-USE PATH EXTENSION.**

WHEREAS, the City of Tempe and State of Arizona have authority under A.R.S. § 11-951 through 11-954 to enter into Intergovernmental Agreements.

WHEREAS, Arizona Revised Statutes § 48-572 allows the City of Tempe to accept grants for or in aid of the construction of statutorily permitted public improvements and enter into contracts with the State for any such improvement.

WHEREAS, the purpose of the agreement is to design an extension of the Western Canal Multi-use Path Project along Divot Drive.

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona will administer the scoping and design of the project, will prepare the plans, estimates and specifications and will also pursue federal funding in support of the project through the Federal Highway Administration.

WHEREAS, the City of Tempe, in order to obtain federal funds for the project, will provide matching funds to the State for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA as follows:

That the Mayor is authorized to sign the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Tempe and the State of Arizona to design the Western Canal Multi-Use Path Extension along Divot Drive.
