ACTION: Approve the utilization of one-year Mohave Educational Services Cooperative contracts with Regional Pavement Maintenance of Arizona, Inc. and Ace Asphalt of Arizona, Inc. for maintenance work on City streets.

FISCAL IMPACT: Total cost of these contracts will not exceed \$250,000. Sufficient funds have been appropriated in the Street Improvement CIP Fund in various cost centers for the anticipated expenditures in the current fiscal year.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the utilization of the contracts.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: (Mohave Educational Service Cooperative 14Y-RPMA-0317 and 14Y-ACE-0317)

Mohave Educational Services Cooperative contracts are written specifically to address the needs of Arizona governmental members and are compliant with the Arizona Procurement Code and Arizona Revised Statutes.

The use of cooperative contracts for roadway maintenance work is a cost effective approach for the City.

These contracts are for routine roadway maintenance work such as slurry seals, crack filling, striping, etc. and are not intended to be used for major road repairs (construction). Pricing has been established on a square foot rate for the various asphalt treatments including slurry seal and micro seal applications.
