ACTION: Adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute the Grant Agreement between the Arizona Criminal Justice Commission and the City of Tempe to accept and disburse a state grant for the provision of CARE 7 victim services. (Resolution No. R2016.75)

FISCAL IMPACT: The amount of the grant award is \$31,005. Sufficient budget appropriations for expenditure of this grant are authorized in the Governmental Grants Fund (Fund 46), as part of the fiscal year 2016-17 adopted budget. Acceptance of the grant requires matching funds in the amount of \$31,005. City-funded personnel time for supervisor and grant oversight will be paid from existing appropriation in the Human Services Department's General Fund budget (Cost Center 2923) to fulfill the required match.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve Resolution No. R2016.75.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The grant funds and City match provide one temporary, non-benefitted part-time CARE 7 trainer. The position will train Human Services staff and City of Tempe first responders on how to integrate practices of trauma-sensitivity and trauma-informed care when providing services to victims. This is the fourteenth consecutive year this grant has been awarded to the City of Tempe's CARE 7 Program.
