ACTION: Adopt a resolution to amend the Tempe City Code, Appendix A - Fee Schedule, Chapter 19, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, related to parking meter rates. (Resolution No. R2016.76)

FISCAL IMPACT: The introduction of differential pricing is designed to efficiently maintain the availability of on-street parking with little or no increase in operating costs/revenue. Variable pricing may result in additional revenue to the City; however, it is not anticipated to exceed \$50,000 per year.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution No. R2016.76.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: At the Work Study Session held June 2, 2016, staff presented the “Downtown Parking and 5th Street Update”. The plan update included a proposal to implement differential pricing in an effort to support efficient use of the City’s on-street parking assets. Carrying out that proposal, this resolution changes the current on-street parking meter rate of \$1.50 per hour to a variable range starting at \$1.00 per hour with a maximum of \$2.00 per hour, depending on the location of the meter.
