Agenda Item: 5C5**

ACTION: Adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign an amendment to the existing intergovernmental agreement between the Arizona Department of Revenue and the City of Tempe relating to tax simplification legislation. (Resolution No. R2016.77)

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no fiscal impact associated with the proposed amendment.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution No. R2016.77.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The City entered into an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) with the Arizona Department of Revenue (ADOR) on June 25, 2015, as required by Arizona Revised Statute 42-6001, related to “tax simplification” legislation. The IGA allowed the parties to modify the agreement if necessary by mutual agreement. Several issues were reviewed in the past year by a group made-up of employees from ADOR, the League of Arizona Cities, and several cities and towns. The proposed IGA modifications are a result of that effort and are recommended for adoption by all cities and towns and serve to clarify the tax administration roles of ADOR.
