

RESOLUTION NO. R2016.78

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE FIRE CHIEF TO SIGN THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF TEMPE FIRE MEDICAL RESCUE DEPARTMENT AND THE CITY OF PHOENIX FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR AMBULANCE LEASE.

WHEREAS, the City of Tempe Fire Medical Rescue Department (“TFMRD”) has obtained an initial certificate of necessity (“CON”) to operate an emergency medical transportation service within the geographical boundaries of Tempe;

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Health Services has granted the initial CON to the City of Tempe pending the acquisition of a vehicle suitable for use as an ambulance;

WHEREAS, the TFMRD is not prepared to immediately purchase a vehicle suitable for use as an ambulance;

WHEREAS, the City of Phoenix Fire Department has agreed to lease a vehicle in their fleet suitable for use as an ambulance to TFMRD; and

WHEREAS, the leased ambulance will satisfy the Arizona Department of Health Services’ requirement under AAC R9-25.902.A.1.i for TFMRD to secure a vehicle suitable for use as an ambulance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, as follows:

That the Fire Chief is authorized to sign the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Tempe Fire Medical Rescue Department and the Phoenix Fire Department for Ambulance Lease and any subsequent related documents that may be necessary to facilitate the transaction.
