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**ACTION:** Approve the utilization of one-year State of Arizona contracts with Genuine Parts Company and Auto Zone for the supply of repair parts for City vehicles and equipment.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Total cost of these two contracts shall not exceed \$200,000 during the one-year contract period. Sufficient funds have been appropriated in the General Fund – cost center 3262 (Fleet Services Maintenance) – for the anticipated expenditures.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the utilization of the contracts.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** (State of Arizona ADSP016-129364) The State of Arizona solicited and awarded contracts for the purchase of aftermarket auto parts utilized to repair vehicles and equipment which contains cooperative language allowing its use by other governmental agencies.

The contracts provide competitive pricing and supplement existing City of Tempe contracts.

The City fleet is made up of approximately 1,150 units comprised of light, medium and heavy duty vehicles as well as parks equipment, construction equipment and other specialized equipment.

These contracts will allow for the purchase of needed repair parts to service City vehicles and equipment.
