ACTION: Approve an agreement amendment with the Tempe Community Action Agency for the purpose of providing senior services at the North Tempe Multi-Generational Center.

FISCAL IMPACT: The agreement amendment requires an annual payment of \$1 from Tempe Community Action Agency to the City.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the agreement amendment.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The City entered into an agreement with Tempe Community Action Agency (TCAA) on August 17, 2006, to provide senior services at the North Tempe Multi-Generational Center. That agreement (C2006-197) expires on August 17, 2016, and both parties would like to exercise the option to extend the current lease for an additional 10 years. The City continues its successful partnership with TCAA; the organization provides senior services, class activities, special events and meals to seniors in the North Tempe neighborhood. The organization brings valuable opportunities to all residents who participate and quality meals to those who are unable to visit the center through the Meals on Wheels program. TCAA has been a beneficial partner with the City of Tempe for more than 40 years, and the Community Services Department anticipates continuing its partnership agreement for many years to come.
