Agenda Item: 5B2

ACTION: Approve the utilization of one-year State of Arizona contracts with Brown's Partsmaster, Inc. and Ferguson Enterprises, Inc. for the purchase of plumbing parts and supplies.

FISCAL IMPACT: Total cost of these contracts will not exceed \$600,000. Sufficient funds have been appropriated in the General Fund – cost center 1871 (Facilities Services), and the Water/Wastewater Fund – cost centers 3003 (Water Utilities Warehouse), 3013 (Johnny G. Martinez Water Treatment Plant) and 3014 (South Tempe Water Treatment Plant) – for the anticipated expenditures.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the utilization of the contracts.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: (ADSP014-074943 and ADSP014-074945) The State of Arizona solicited and awarded contracts for the purchase of plumbing parts and supplies which contain cooperative language allowing their use by other governmental agencies.

The State of Arizona utilized a competitive bid process that established pricing based on significant purchase volumes anticipated for the State and other participating governmental agencies. Contract pricing is based on a percentage discount off of list price.

The contracts will be used to purchase plumbing parts and supplies necessary for the maintenance and repair of City buildings and facilities.
