ACTION: Approve an amendment to the Emergency Ambulance Transportation Contract between Professional Medical Transport and the City of Tempe for a 12-month extension.

FISCAL IMPACT: None.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the First Amendment to Emergency Ambulance Transportation Contract.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: In 2014, the City negotiated and entered into an Emergency Ambulance Transportation Contract for the provision of ambulance service with Professional Medical Transport (PMT) for an initial period of two (2) years with the option for three (3) one-year extensions. Subsequently an Amended and Restated Emergency Medical Transportation Agreement was negotiated in 2016. The pending Amended and Restated Emergency Medical Transportation Agreement will be in force upon the issuance, by Arizona Department of Health Services, of a final Certificate of Necessity (CON). By extending the current agreement, no gap in coverage will exist between the two contracts.
