ACTION: Adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Phoenix to provide Federal Transit Administration grant funds for the East Valley Bus Operations and Maintenance Facility Building System Improvements and Carbon Dioxide Sensor Replacements. (Resolution No. R2016.95)

FISCAL IMPACT: Grant AZ-2016-010-00 will provide \$1,200,000 in federal funds, which will directly offset budgeted expenditures for East Valley Bus Operations and Maintenance Facility HVAC improvements & CO2 Sensor Replacements. The local match necessary for the grant is \$300,000 and is budgeted in Transit Fund cost center 6006089.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution No. R2016.95.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The City of Tempe received Grant AZ-2016-010-00, which provides \$1,200,000 in federal funds for the construction of improvements to facility operations and safety at the East Valley Bus Operations and Maintenance Facility. The amount is a replacement of the \$1.2 million committed out of the Tempe Transit Tax funds for the project. These funds are intended to help the City of Tempe provide a better transit facility. The federal grant reduces the current City of Tempe contribution for the completion of the project by \$1.2 million. Provided below is a project summary.
