

RESOLUTION NO. R2016.95

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF PHOENIX TO PROVIDE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION GRANT FUNDS FOR THE EAST VALLEY BUS OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE FACILITY BUILDING SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS AND CARBON DIXOIDE SENSOR REPLACEMENTS.

WHEREAS, Chapter 53 of 49 United States Code (formerly the Federal Transit Act of 1964, as amended) makes financial aid available to municipalities and local units of government showing a substantial effort toward the preservation, improvement and operation of mass transit systems; and

WHEREAS, the City of Phoenix, who is the designated recipient by the FTA for the Phoenix -Mesa Urbanized area, is responsible for receiving, distributing and tracking federal funds to sub-recipients, including the City of Tempe; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Tempe applied for unspent federal formula funds provided by the FTA's Urbanized Area Formula Grants 49 U.S.C. § 5307, to fund the construction of improvements to the Building Systems and Carbon Dioxide Sensor Replacements at the East Valley Bus Operations and Maintenance Facility; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with the Grant No.AZ-2016-010-00, the Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Phoenix and the City of Tempe sets forth the duties and responsibilities of the parties and the term of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Intergovernmental Agreement, the City shall receive grant funds as reimbursements for the federal share of the expenditures associated the construction of improvements to the Building Systems and Carbon Dioxide Sensor Replacements; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the associated Intergovernmental Agreement, the City of Tempe shall receive grant funds of \$1,200,000 as reimbursement for the federal share of expenditures related to the transit facility improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, as follows:

The Intergovernmental Agreement specified herein between the City of Phoenix and the City of Tempe is approved and the Mayor is authorized to sign the Intergovernmental Agreement.
