ACTION: Adopt a resolution authorizing the Chief of Police or designee(s), to execute a grant award agreement between the State of Arizona, Governor's Office of Highway Safety and the Tempe Police Department to accept funding for overtime and employee related expenses to enhance the Selective Traffic Enforcement Program Enforcement. (Resolution No. R2016.99)

FISCAL IMPACT: The amount of the total grant award is \$75,000. This grant award will supplement the Police Department's existing General Fund budget appropriation. Sufficient budget appropriation for expenditure of this grant was authorized in the Police Grants and Restricted Revenue Fund (Fund 45) as part of the fiscal year 2016-17 adopted budget.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution No. R2016.99.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The Tempe Police Department will utilize this grant funding for overtime and employee related expenses to 1) identify the most dangerous roads within a specific geographic area and deploy resources based on the identification process; 2) focus week/month long enforcement details at 'top 5' collision intersections as determined by data analysis; 3) utilize the Traffic Management Center and statistical analysis to better facilitate the movement of traffic through the top 10 collision intersections; and 4) include speed and other selective enforcement as part of other enforcement programs such as DUI and occupant protection.
