**ACTION:** Approve the utilization of a three-month Mohave Educational Services Cooperative, Inc. contract with General Acrylics, Inc. for resurfacing the basketball courts at Hollis Park and Redden Park.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Total spending on this contract will not exceed \$55,000 during the three-month contract period (ending January 31, 2017). Sufficient funds have been appropriated in the Park Improvement/Recreation Capital Improvement Project Fund cost center 6305119 (Concrete and Court Replacement/Renovation) for the anticipated expenditures in the current fiscal year.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the utilization of the contract.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** (150-GAI3-0201) Mohave Educational Services Cooperative, Inc. (Mohave) solicited bids and awarded a contract for the resurfacing of sports courts. The primary purpose of Mohave is to establish the means by which participating agencies in the State of Arizona may join together in a cooperative contracting effort in order to achieve cost effective and efficient acquisition of quality products and services. Mohave follows procurement regulations that are similar to the City's and has a robust contract administration process that ensures contract compliance.

This contract will be used to resurface basketball courts at Hollis Park and Redden Park.

**General Pricing for Contracts**

Mohave utilized a competitive bid process that established discounts off list pricing for materials and supplies, hourly rates for labor and unit pricing per square foot for court maintenance. Discounts range from 1% to 17% off materials and accessories. Labor rates range from \$31.35 to \$200.00 per hour and square foot unit rates rate from \$0.06 to \$0.28 based on the total project square footage.
