ACTION: Adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute an intergovernmental agreement between the Tempe Union High School District and the City of Tempe for the provision of school-based prevention programming services. (Resolution No. R2016.110)

FISCAL IMPACT: The amount of the grant funding for these services is not to exceed \$69,149, payable before June 30, 2017. Sufficient budget appropriation for expenditure of this grant is authorized in the Governmental Grants Fund (Fund 46) as part of the Fiscal Year 2016-17 adopted budget.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution No. R2016.110.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The grant funds provided by the Tempe Union High School District will be used to place six clinically-trained City Counselors in seven High Schools two days a week throughout the school year to provide crisis intervention, prevention services, in-service training, life skills training, support groups, assessment and referral resources, and counseling for identified “at-risk” high school students and their families. This is the twenty-second year of this Intergovernmental Agreement.
