

RESOLUTION NO. R2016.110

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE TEMPE UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 213 FOR SCHOOL-BASED PREVENTION PROGRAMMING SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City of Tempe and the Tempe Union High School District No. 213 (“District”) desire to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement for the provision of school-based prevention programming services to District students; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes and acknowledges that the District’s prevention programming services offers numerous benefits to the community and the general public by providing programs to establish accountability-based programs designed to reduce substance abuse and other harmful behaviors among Tempe youth; and,

WHEREAS, the City is authorized by A.R.S. § 11-951, *et seq.*, and City of Tempe Charter § 1.03 to enter into this Intergovernmental Agreement, and the City Council has authorized the Mayor to sign this Intergovernmental Agreement on behalf of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, hereby:

1. That authorization is granted to the Mayor to sign the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Tempe Union High School District and the City of Tempe; and
2. The Mayor or his designee may execute and submit any additional documents relating to this Intergovernmental Agreement, including but not limited to amendments, addenda and any other necessary or desirable instruments.
