ACTION: Adopt a resolution declaring the canvass of results for the November 8, 2016 Special Bond Election. (Resolution No. R2016.115)

FISCAL IMPACT: None.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt Resolution No. R2016.115.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The City of Tempe Special Bond Election was held on Tuesday, November 8, 2016 for the purpose of submitting five bond questions to the qualified electors of the City, as follows:

- Question No. 1: Water and Sewer Improvements - \$148,000,000
- Question No. 2: Street Improvements/Storm Drains - \$25,000,000
- Question No. 3: Public Safety - \$20,000,000
- Question No. 4: Park Improvements/Community Services - \$34,000,000
- Question No. 5: Municipal Infrastructure Preservation - \$27,000,000

All five bond questions were approved by the voters. The results of the election are contained in the official canvass to be adopted by resolution. Arizona Revised Statutes (ARS) § 16-642 requires the City Council to meet and canvass the election results not less than six days nor more than twenty days following the election. ARS § 16-646 requires the official canvass to contain certain information which is included in the attached resolution:

- 1) the number of ballots cast in each precinct
- 2) the number of ballots rejected in each precinct
- 3) the number and brief title of each bond question
- 4) the number of votes by precinct for and against each bond question
