ACTION: Authorize the Mayor to execute a Wired Telecommunications and Right-of-Way Use Agreement between Sprint Communications Company L.P. and the City of Tempe.

FISCAL IMPACT: Facilities owned by Sprint occupying the right-of-way are subject to a \$2.15 per linear foot fee, which is adjusted yearly based on the consumer price index. The initial annual fee of \$34,290.35 is based on 15,949 linear feet of trench in the right-of-way. Sprint will also pay any applicable permit fees, street damage fees, and reasonable costs associated with any construction, maintenance, and operation of its facilities.

RECOMMENDATION: Authorize the Mayor to execute the Agreement.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Sprint has used the City's right-of-way since 1991 to provide interstate telecommunications and its current license expires on December 13, 2016. Sprint wishes to continue to use the right-of-way to provide its services for an additional five-year term beyond the expiration date of its current license (C2011-209).
