**ACTION:** Adopt a resolution authorizing the Tempe Fire Medical Rescue Chief to ratify the executed Subrecipient Award Agreement between the Arizona Department of Homeland Security and the City of Tempe for the purpose of accepting and spending a federal grant in order to sustain the Tempe Fire Medical Rescue Department's Terrorism Liaison Officer. (Resolution No. R2017.02)

**FISCAL IMPACT:** The amount of the grant award is \$1,420 in federal funds. Acceptance of this grant does not require any matching City funds. Sufficient budget appropriation for expenditure of this grant is authorized in the Governmental Grants Fund (Fund 46) as part of the FY 2016-17 adopted budget.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution No. R2017.02.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** This Department of Homeland Security State Homeland Security Grant 2016 Sustain Tempe Fire Medical Rescue Department's Terrorism Liaison Officer is designated to cover the cost of telecommunication services for the TLO and Special Operations team. Specifically, it will pay for satellite data service and Mifi accounts.
