**ACTION:** Adopt a resolution authorizing the Tempe Fire Medical Rescue Chief to ratify the executed Subrecipient Award Agreement between the Arizona Department of Homeland Security and the City of Tempe for the purpose of accepting and spending a federal grant in order to support the Tempe Fire Medical Rescue Department's program entitled Sustain Tempe Fire Medical Rescue Rapid Response Team Program. (Resolution No. R2017.03)

**FISCAL IMPACT:** The amount of the grant award is \$100,000 in federal funds. Acceptance of this grant does not require any matching City funds. Sufficient budget appropriation for expenditure of this grant is authorized in the Governmental Grants Fund (Fund 46) as part of the FY 2016-17 adopted budget.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt Resolution No. R2017.03.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** This Department of Homeland Security Urban Area Security Initiative Grant 2016 Sustain Tempe Fire Medical Rescue Department's RRT is designated to cover the cost of training and equipment for the technical rescue team and hazardous materials team. The equipment will include hazardous materials and radiation meters as well technical rescue equipment.
