

RESOLUTION NO 2012.93

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF GILBERT FOR THE JUVENILE ACCOUNTABILITY BLOCK GRANT JB-CSG-12-2366-09.

WHEREAS, the Town of Gilbert and the City of Tempe desire to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement for the provision of services to at-risk juveniles in the Town of Gilbert; and

WHEREAS, the City of Tempe desires to convey to Gilbert a portion of its 2012 Juvenile Accountability Block Grant funds (“Funds”) received through the State of Arizona, Governor’s Office for Children, Youth and Families, Division for Children, for the provision of services for the Adolescent Life Fundamentals Program administered by Gilbert; and,

WHEREAS, the City recognizes and acknowledges that Gilbert’s Adolescent Life Fundamentals Program offers numerous benefits to the community and the general public by providing programs to establish accountability-based programs designed to reduce recidivism among juveniles who are referred by law enforcement personnel or agencies; and,

WHEREAS, the City desires to disburse the Funds to Gilbert and to set forth the mutual understandings between the City and Gilbert; and,

WHEREAS, the City is authorized by A.R.S. § 11-951, *et seq.*, and City of Tempe Charter § 1.03 to enter into this Intergovernmental Agreement, and the City Council has authorized the Mayor to sign this Intergovernmental Agreement on behalf of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TEMPE, ARIZONA, hereby:

1. Grants approval of the request to convey a portion of its 2012 Juvenile Accountability Block Grant funds received through the State of Arizona, Governor’s Office for Children, Youth and Families, Division for Children, in the amount of \$2,619.00 through an Intergovernmental Agreement; and
2. Grants authorization to the Mayor to sign the Intergovernmental Agreement between the Town of Gilbert and the City of Tempe; and
3. Grants approval of the request to disburse the grant funds and/or incur related allowable expenses; and
4. Gives authority to the Community Services Department and Community Services Director or her designee, to act as agent of the City of Tempe to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, billing statements, and any other necessary or desirable instruments in connection with such funding.
